Have you heard the good news? National Grid have at last bowed to public pressure and will be holding an **exhibition in Nailsea on the 26<sup>th</sup> November** (2-4pm and 6-8pm at Scotch Horn). Well done to everyone who wrote and emailed to apply pressure on them not to ignore us. This shows clearly that together we can make a difference.

We don't think it's a coincidence that they announced this u-turn just after we had invited them to attend the Save Our Valley Public Meeting on 27 November!
