Hinkley C Connection Project

I am responding to your consultation on the Hinkley C to Avonmouth electricity connection.

The best option would be to put the cables under the sea. I know that you have said this is too expensive and/or technically too difficult but you have not persuaded me that the extra cost is not worth it.

If you have to put the cables overland then please do not surround our community with power lines. Adding pylons to the South and East of Nailsea – in addition to the pylons already in West Nailsea – is not an option. Corridor 2 must be rejected outright.

If the undersea option proves to be impossible then the two existing sets of 132kV lines in the West of Nailsea, together with the new 400kV lines, must be put underground for the short stretch closest to Nailsea and Tickenham.

Finally, if a new overground line in Corridor 1a is unavoidable, then both existing sets of 132kV lines in the West of Nailsea must be removed and the replacement lines must be sited well away from homes.
